installing a sky bridge that will connect
Salt Lake's Primary Children's Hospital
to the University of Utah's new ACC
Center. The Ambulatory Care Center
will be a state-of-the-art clinic facility for
same-day procedures and administration
for Primary Children's Medical Center
and the University of Utah Hospitals
and Clinics. This bridge installation was
an exciting and critical step for this ACC
project's construction process.





As seen in the picture to the left, several patients and other observers "camped out" and watched the installation of the bridge. For a special treat to all of the construction workers involved, the patients at primary children's hospital sang "Bridge Over Troubled Water" as the bridge was installed. There were also live DJ's, popcorn, drinks, and all sorts of treats to celebrate this late-night event. The construction of the bridge began Friday night and was completed by Saturday night.
