PCS Augusta, GA LR1750 Crane

Mountain Crane Service performed its heaviest lift to date with a **Liebherr LR1750 Crawler Crane**. Working with Barnhart Crane and PCS, Mountain Crane performed a series of heavy lifts on site in Augusta, GA.

The crane was configured with 230 ft. Main (S) Boom and 131 ft. Derrick. There were 485,000 lbs. Superstructure Ctwt, 209,000 lbs. Carbody Ctwt, and 643,000 lbs. Ctwt on the Ballast Wagon.









The crane erection was supervised by Travis Horton was done on time and safety compliant. The crane was operated by Roy Justice (day shift) and Ryan Neff (night shift). All crew members were recognized for their performance during these critical lifts.

The heaviest of the lifts was 551,000 lbs., which

was walked into the unit and set at a 85 ft. radius. The second heaviest lift was 530,000 lbs. set in place at a 95 ft. radius.

Mountain Crane Service assisted the Jazz Bear in setting a new world record at the Lehi High School Mascot Bowl. The Jazz Bear launched a hail marry from atop Mountain Crane's 350 ft. tall Liebherr LTM 1160 200 Ton All Terrain. This broke the world record for highest-thrownand-caught-football. The Jazz Bear's throw reached speeds of over 80 mph!
