
A lattice crawler, such as this Linkbelt LS348 equipped with luffer attachement was just the trick for the tight spaces of the downtown City Creek project.

Recently, our team lifted 40 electrolyzers (weighing 165K lbs each) off the rail line and onto 6 lines of THP Goldhofer trailer. Once the Goldhofer moved the units across the laydown yard, the crane picked each unit and set



it on our 9 axle Trail King for over-the-road transport.




